28.0 Purpose and Scope

This chapter provides general guidelines and instructions on recording relationships between items.

28.1 Related Items

28.1.1 Basic Instructions on Referencing Related Items

28.1.1.1 Scope

A **related item** is an item related to the resource being described (e.g., an item used as the basis for a microform reproduction).

28.1.1.2 Sources of Information

Take information on related items from any source.

28.1.1.3 Referencing Related Items

Reference a related item applying with the general guidelines on referencing related works, expressions, manifestations, and items given under **24.4 RDA**.

FOR EXAMPLE:

Identifier for the Related Item

Facsimile of: Bodleian

Library: MS. Junius 11

Accession number provided for related item

FOR EXAMPLE:

Reproduction of: ADM 55/40

Piece number provided for related item held by The National Archives, Kew

FOR EXAMPLE:

Structured Description of the Related Item

Bound with: Report of the Committee on the District of Columbia in relation to the city of Washington : read in Senate, February 2, 1835. — City of Washington : Printed at the Globe Office, 1835

Resource described: Memorial of the Committee of the Corporation of Washington : relating to the pecuniary claims of said corporation on the general government, &c. — [Washington : publisher not identified, 1835] (Washington : Blair & Rives).

Library of Congress copy

FOR EXAMPLE:

Unstructured Description of the Related Item

Reproduction of original from Harvard Law School Library

Library's copy bound with 11 other songs

Electronic reproduction of more than 9,000 notarial protocols registered in the books of the notaries Joseph Manuel Alvarez de Aragón (1701–1743) and Joseph Alvarez (1780–1821)

Library's copy has separately published index bound with each volume

Electronic reproduction of the copy in the National Wetlands Research Center Library

Original letters in the collection of the Watkinson Library, Trinity College, Hartford, Connecticut
