General Comments

The British Library welcomes the proposals by the Library of Congress for the simplification of instructions in this area and supports the intentions expressed in this proposal as further clarified by LC/12/LC follow-up/2.

Comments on specific instructions

6.2.3.3.2:

It would be helpful to show the relationship between the alternative name and the preferred access point in the examples. For example, an explanation of the first example could be provided as follows:

"Mozart, Wolfgang Amadeus, 1756-1791. Concertos, piano, orchestra, K. 491, C minor. Cadenza

(Is an alternative name (variant title) of the preferred access point: Previn, Andre, 1929- Cadenza to Mozart's piano concerto in C minor)"
