Access point for an audio recording of music performed at the 1956-1965 festivals Intermountain West Student Philosophy Conference Access point for its website

Annual Symposium on Sea Turtle Biology and Conservation Access point for its proceedings described as a serial

If additions are required to distinguish two or more series of conferences, etc., with the name or a name so similar that they may be confused, apply the instructions at 11.13.1.2–11.13.1.7, as applicable.
