CCC thanks the British Library for proposing these changes to provide clarity and the removal of ambiguity. CCC supports this proposal and provides the following comments for consideration.

- 1. Add a link to the 2011 ISBD consolidated edition from the Other Resources drop-down list in the Resources tab of the RDA Toolkit.
- 2. Within CCC, there were questions about conformance of the citation to ISBD Consolidated to the current edition of the Chicago Manual of Style. Given that the RDA Toolkit contains several citations to external resources, perhaps these could be reviewed for CMOS conformance.
- 3. We note that Appendix D is based partly on the 2007 version of ISBD and partly on the 2011 version and realize it may be a larger task to update accordingly.
- 4. Changes paralleling the wording changes in D.0 could be made in E.0 to maintain the parallel structure. CCC proposes these changes herewith.
