Subject: Other place associated with the person: Revision of RDA
9.11

CILIP thanks BL for its proposed revision.

CILIP agrees in principle with the proposal.

CILIP prefers that “a place where a person has resided” is the first example given at RDA 9.11.1.1 Scope, to show that the element is an expansion from that specific definition, and to ensure that place of residence is treated as a sub-type in applications of RDA.

CILIP suggests that “a place a person has attacked” is added to the examples given at RDA 9.11.1.1 Scope, because it is specifically listed as an instance where the BL has found it useful to record the place.

CILIP asks if the scope of the expanded element covers fictitious or legendary places that a person has written about.
