Subject: Proposed revision to Appendix B.1 General Guideline to explicitly include

the usage of units of measure expressed as symbols

CCC proposes the following revision to the alternative in B.1 General Guideline in Appendix B, Abbreviations.

As currently written this alternative does not explicitly state that guidelines on the use of symbols are allowed. Système international (SI) units of measure are recorded as symbols, not abbreviations. Furthermore, SI usage has expanded to include SI-compatible symbols representing frequently-used non-metric units of measure as seen in ISO 80000-3:2006 *Quantities and units -- Part 3: Space and time*.

Including the explicit statement proposed below will accommodate the in-house guidelines for the usage of SI symbols developed and followed by Library and Archives Canada, and support JSC's intent to advance the internationalization of RDA.
