Subject: Performances - addition of examples at RDA 6.12.1.3, 6.27.3

CCC agrees with the proposal to add examples to RDA 6.12.1.3 and 6.27.3 demonstrating the use of conductor and performer names as other distinguishing characteristics of an expression.

We suggest the following corrections to the proposed examples:

Furtwängler

A performance of Richard Wagner's Tristan und Isolde conducted by Wilhelm Furtwängler and recorded in 1952

Böhm

Another performance of Richard Wagner's Tristan und Isolde conducted by Karl Böhm and recorded in 1966

Alban Berg Quartett

A performance of Ludwig van Beethoven's String Qquartet in E flat major Qop. 127 by the Alban Berg Quartett recorded in 1981

Artemis Quartett

Another performance of Ludwig van Beethoven's String $Q\underline{q}$ uartet in E flat major $Q\underline{q}$ by the Artemis Quartett recorded in 2010

CCC agrees with adding an example at 6.27.3 but we note the proposed example will be invalid if 6JSC/CCC/7 is accepted because it illustrates a case of a compilation of all of the tworks of one type by a composer consisting of a consecutively numbered group. We propose a different example be added following 6.27.3:

Wagner, Richard, 1813-1883. Tristan und Isolde (Furtwängler)

Resource described: Tristan and Isolde / Wagner. An audio recording made in 1952 of a performance of the opera conducted by Wilhelm Furtwängler

If the proposed Beethoven example is retained, a period should be added after "no". The words in the note "in other years" are not appropriate because this example does not include the date of the recording. We counter-propose this note:

Other performances of Beethoven's complete sonatas for violin and piano have been recorded <u>by other performers</u>.
