SUBJECT: Clarifying Date Associated with the Person and Core Requirements

Background

Instructions 0.6.4, 8.3, and 9.3.1.3 presently do not consistently provide for recording the elements either as parts of the authorized access point representing the person, family, or corporate body, or as separate elements, or as both. Minor changes in the wording of the statement are proposed for clarification.

Instructions 0.6.4, 8.3, and 9.3.1.3 need to indicate which element subtypes of "Date associated with a person" are core and which "core when."

"Period of activity of the person" needs to be added to the second list in instructions 0.6.4 and 8.3 as an identity element that can be used for differentiation.

Proposed revisions of 0.6.4.

Add a new sentence to the first paragraph at 0.6.4; modify the first list at 0.6.4; modify the statement preceding the second list at 0.6.4; add to the second list at 0.6.4.

Record the elements either as additions parts to of the authorized access point representing the person, family, or corporate body, or as separate elements, or as both.

Add a new sentence in the statement preceding the first list in 8.3; modify the first list; modify the statement preceding the second list; add to the second list.

8.3 Core Elements

When recording data identifying a person, family, or corporate body, include as a minimum the elements listed below that are applicable and readily ascertainable. Record the elements either as parts of the authorized access point representing the person, family, or corporate body, or as separate elements or as both.

Proposed revision to 9.3.1.3.

Add a new sentence at 9.3.1.3.

9.3.1.3 Recording Dates Associated with Persons

Record dates in terms of the calendar preferred by the agency creating the date. For details on the Christian calendar, see appendix H.

Record dates either as a part of the authorized access point representing the person, or as a separate element, or as both.

Record a date associated with a person by giving the year alone.
