These topics were discussed by the JSC in relation to other proposals and discussion papers submitted to its meeting in November 2014 as well as the current work on FR consolidation.

At this stage the JSC strategy is **to set up a group to consider the topic of aggregations**, preferably in collaboration with the FRBR Review Group. Proposals, discussion papers, and comments on this topic will be referred to the new group for its consideration, and the JSC will pass on the concerns raised by EURIG."

EURIG Response to RDA Governance Structure





To: Committee of Principals

From: European RDA Interest Group

Subject: RDA Governance Review Consultation

The European RDA Interest Group (EURIG) has studied the RDA Governance Review document and approves of the principles for a new governance model and the areas chosen for development.

1.) How do you think the Governance Structure could be improved?

EURIG agrees that the current governance model will not work when more countries move towards RDA – new stakeholders and members need to have more chances to having their opinions raised. One solution mentioned in the discussion document is the possibility of establishing working groups within specific problem areas where people from constituencies can be represented. But as there are more stakeholders than the JSC constituencies we appreciate the option mentioned in the discussion document: moving away from specific constituency representation to a new way of representation based on the mix of knowledge, skills, and expertise of the selected representatives.

Tasks 2014



11 tasks were assigned to the JSC Music Working Group.

The group prepared and submitted revision proposals for the following six tasks:

- (2) Review RDA 6.14 to simplify and clarify the instructions for choosing and recording preferred titles of musical works.
 Proposal submitted.
- (3) Review RDA 3.6 and determine if an additional sub-element is needed for the base material of audio recordings.

 No additional sub-element needed, however additional terms for the list at 3.6.1.3 were deemed necessary.
- (4) Review RDA 3.7 and determine if an additional sub-element is needed for the applied material on audio recordings. Prepare a proposal for the 2014 JSC meeting.

No additional sub-element needed, however additional terms for the list at 3.7.1.3 were deemed necessary.

Tasks 2014 continued



• (5) Revise RDA 6.28.3.1 so that the instruction allows the use of elements prescribed under RDA 6.27.3 in conjunction with those prescribed under RDA 6.28.3.1-6.28.3.5.

Proposal submitted.

• (6) Review instructions and terms from RDA 6.14.2.8.3-6.14.2.8.5 and RDA 7.20 in the RDA Glossary and consider options for improving the presentation of terms in RDA 6.14.2.8.4-6.14.2.8.5 and avoiding the need for Glossary entries: propose better formed definitions of the terms as exemplars of construction patterns; reference one or more external vocabularies; revert to use of examples.

Proposal submitted.

• (11) Investigate the dependencies between RDA 3.4.3.2 Exceptions and RDA 3.22.2.5 to determine if RDA 3.22.2.5 is redundant.

Proposal submitted.



Tasks 2015 (including the remaining tasks from 2014)

- Investigate music vocabularies external to RDA and determine their suitability as sources of terms for music-related elements in the RDA element set.
- Review RDA 6.15 and develop proposals that will align the application of the instructions for use with external vocabularies of medium of performance terms, taking into account RDA 0.12 and avoiding references to specific external vocabularies.
- Review RDA 6.16.1.3.1 and investigate whether the definition of serial number can be expanded and determine if further guidance is needed for recording serial numbers.
- Investigate if a new element of Medium of Performance of the Expression is needed in RDA. Determine if the addition of this element would assist users in finding, identifying, and selecting to change with each expression.



Tasks 2015, continued

- Review the instructions at RDA 6.28.1-6.28.3 and determine if any of the instructions would be better suited as instructions in RDA 6.14 or in chapters 19-20, especially as it concerns the treatment of adaptations, arrangements, and added accompaniments.
- Investigate RDA 6.28.1.10 and determine if the method for resolving conflicts between authorized access points is too restrictive.
- Investigate 6.28.1.11 and determine if other additions to the authorized access points for compilations of musical works are necessary.

- 2 proposal documents submitted for the JSC meeting in November 2014:
 - 6JSC/ROFWG/1: Proposals for a namespace for the Framework
 - The JSC agreed to implement the namespace for the RDA/ONIX Framework as detailed in the paper.
 - 6JSC/ROFWG/2: JSC recommendations for extension and revision of the Framework
 - The JSC welcomed the advice given in the paper, and will proceed with relevant changes to RDA in due course.
- 4 of the WG tasks for 2014 completed or partially adressed by these 2 proposal documents

RDA/ONIX Framework



- Tasks for 2015
 - Review and take forward recommendation #3 in 6JSC/ALA/Discussion/1.
 - Recommend labels to supplement RDA controlled vocabularies for resource categorization for application in user friendly displays, in collaboration with the RDA Technical Working Group.
 - Create guidelines and explanations on proposing new terms in the RDA carrier type, content type, and media type value vocabularies using qualified ROF categories, based on 6JSC/ROFWG/2, by Apr. 30, 2015.

RDA/ONIX Framework



- Tasks for 2015
 - Monitor and liaise with any further activities related to 6JSC/ALA/Discussion/1 by ALA's Task Force on Machine-Actionable Data or its successor.
 - Investigate the application of the ROF, and specifically the Character attribute, to the RDA element "Nature of the content" and the potential element "Nature of the work".
 - Review the current provision for categorization of resources expressed through movement, taking into account the CCC response to Q1 in 6JSC/LC rep/4.

- Explore the issues related to "statements" as aggregates of RDA elements and make proposals based on findings

Capitalization



Assist the JSC in the revision and development of Appendix A Capitalization and related instructions in *RDA*.

- Review the content and coverage of RDA Appendix A and prepare a proposals/discussion paper by Aug. 3, 2015.
 - 1. Review the instructions on capitalization of RDA elements (A.0-A.9) to ensure these are complete.
 - Propose possible paths for presenting the languagespecific capitalization instructions in a way that is useful for cataloguers working in the translations of RDA as well as those working in English.
 - 3. Identify updates needed in specific languages, where the relevant expertise for that language is available.

Aggregates



Assist the JSC in developing RDA for application to aggregated resources

- Investigate the issues for developing RDA instructions and elements for aggregate resources and prepare a proposals/discussion paper by Aug. 3, 2015.
 - Review RDA compliance with the models presented in the main part and appendix of the Final Report of the Working Group on Aggregates.
 - Investigate the utility of FRBRoo sub-classes of Work, Expression, and Manifestation for the description of aggregates in RDA.
- Liaise with the JSC Music Working Group and JSC Technical Working Group on issues of mutual interest.

Fictitious Entities



Assist the JSC in developing RDA for application to fictitious entities

- 1. Review the RDA treatment of fictitious persons in the context of a consolidated FRBR model which treats a fictitious person as a Name/Nome of a real Person entity and prepare a proposals/discussion paper by Aug. 3, 2015.
- Investigate the future RDA treatment of fictitious families and corporate bodies and prepare a proposals/discussion paper by Aug. 3, 2015.
- 3. Investigate the requirements for extending the RDA treatment of fictitious agents to other RDA entities, including Work, Expression, Manifestation, and Item, and potential entities such as Place.
- 4. Liaise with the JSC Technical Working Group on issues of the treatment of authorities in *RDA*.
- 5. Liaise with the JSC Places Working Group on issue of fictitious places.

Relationship designators



Assist the JSC in the revision and development of relationship designators for describing relationships between entities in RDA.

- 1. Investigate the requirements and review the treatment and structure of relationship designators in RDA Toolkit, and prepare proposal/discussion papers, by Aug. 3, 2015.
 - 1. Clarify the relationship of designators to elements.
 - 2. Clarify the requirements of same-entity and crossentity designators.
- 2. Prepare a proposal/discussion paper for the organization of designators between Persons, Families, and Corporate Bodies in Appendix K, by Aug. 3, 2015.

Relationship designators



- 3. Review the use of parenthetical entity qualifiers and investigate alternative approaches to designator labels.
- Propose guidelines on submitting new relationship designators, including labels, definitions, scope, and hierarchies, by Aug. 3, 2015.

6JSC/Technical WG/4 Court and Jurisdiction in RDA

Clarification of the term "jurisdiction"

Widely used in RDA but not defined

Refers to Corporate Body and Place

RDA Usage



- a political jurisdiction refers to a corporate body that governs a geographic area , e.g. Cabinet, **Court**, Council
- a territorial jurisdiction refers to a geographic area that is governed by a political body, e.g. state, province
- an ecclesiastical jurisdiction refers to a geographic area that is governed by a religious body, e.g. diocese, synod, parish
- a religious jurisdiction refers to a corporate body that governs an ecclesiastical jurisdiction, e.g. Franciscans,

Recommendations



Jurisdiction

Definition: "A place/geographic area under the legal authority of or governed by a corporate body."

• Scope note: "Jurisdictions may include territorial jurisdictions governed by political bodies and ecclesiastical jurisdictions governed by religious bodies.

Replace the terms:

"political jurisdiction" with "political body" or a similar term,

"religious jurisdiction" with "religious body" or a similar term.
