### **Community resources**

This area of **RDA toolkit** holds content that conforms to the RDA standard but is specific to language or specialist communities rather than international in scope.

Community resources is subarranged into two areas:

- Community refinements = provides additional guidance and instructions for existing RDA elements that are applicable to specific communities
- Community vocabularies 1 provides controlled terms for use as values of specific RDA elements using specialized community-based vocabularies or language-based vocabularies.

#### **Purpose:**

to support the improvement of the RDA standard for elements that use measurements, primarily extent and dimensions elements, by focusing on applying Extent in a machine-actionable way

- Lively discussion of:
  - o encoding systems and Vocabulary Encoding Systems
  - description of capture of numerical/measurement data in machine-actionable format
  - o the terms "sheet," "page," and "leaf" as used by the monographic and special materials communities
- Attempts to use the AUQ model for still images
- No formal papers have been presented

# Religions in RDA Working Group

#### **Purpose:**

to support the improvement of the RDA standard by reviewing the guidance and instructions (in all RDA entities) and making recommendations to move RDA toward unbiased and inclusive treatment of world religions. A specific and more immediate goal is to expand the non-Christian coverage in RDA. RSC concerns include the emphasis given to Christianity and books of the Bible and the lack of attention to other religious texts
