Subject: Formal response to RSC/ExtentWG/2025/3, Proposal for Manifestation:  
**extent of unit** and its subtype elements

EURIG thanks the Extent WG for this family of proposals.

We acknowledge the development of RDA as a standard which is optimized for machine actionability and linked data applications and that for these applications a more granular approach to recording values for extent may be desirable.

In general we would like to see a more complete modelling of the prerecording and recording sections for “extent of unit” and an inclusion of recording methods and related elements in standard RDA element page layout.
