Subject: RSC Report, May 2025

Because of the Joint Meeting of the RDA Board and the RSC on 7 April ([RSC-RDABoard/Minutes/010-022](#)) there is little new to share. The Minutes of the April 2025 Meeting of the RSC have been published today ([RSC/Minutes/508-520](#)) and Board members are asked to read through them to keep abreast of anything discussed there and not at the Board meeting.

You may also be interested in the workshop that NARDAC and the PCC are running on 27 June. This is a preconference event at ALA Annual in Philadelphia. It will preview some of the PCC RDA Training Phase II work as well as a sampling of the bridge training that is being prepared. It will focus on identifying changes in cataloguing practice relating to the official RDA Toolkit and relevant documentation, including LC-PCC Policy Statements and Metadata Guidance Documentation (MGD). Examples, hands-on exercises, interactive Q&A will be provided in the workshop to help cataloguers prepare for cataloguing using official RDA. Registration is open [here](#).
