Implementation of Official RDA

As part of its implementation of the official RDA Toolkit, the Program for Cooperative Cataloging (PCC) is committed to providing documentation and training, including the following:

- Metadata Application Profiles (MAPs)
- Training for cataloging print and electronic books and serials
- Training for creating and updating LC/NACO authority records

Documentation

LC-PCC Policy Statements (LC-PCC PSs)

- Ongoing updates to LC-PCC PSs based on work from PTCP staff and feedback submitted via the [PCC RDA Communications Committee Feedback Form](#)
- Updates coincide with RDA Toolkit releases in February, June, and October
- February 2026 release: 60 LC-PCC PS revisions, many were updates to change DCRM(B) to DCRMR

Metadata Guidance Documentation (MGDs)

- Ongoing updates to MGDs based on work from PTCP staff and feedback submitted via the [PCC RDA Communications Committee Feedback Form](#)
- New Metadata Guidance Documentation Subgroup
 - Working on major revisions to MGDs, such as rewriting large sections, creating thorough examples, and writing new MGDs
 - Work assigned based on feedback submitted to the PCC RDA Communications Committee

- BIBCO Standard Record (BSR) Official RDA Metadata Application Profile

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report Purpose

- To inform PCC and the larger cataloging community of changes from original RDA to official RDA for monographs and the impact of those changes on PCC practices
- To serve as a reference for experienced RDA catalogers to look up common terms and elements from original RDA and find their corresponding term or element in official RDA
- To illustrate how values of official RDA elements may be encoded in MARC 21 bibliographic records when there are possible changes from original RDA

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report New and Important Terminology

- A single list of important terms for official RDA
- Includes some new terms and terms with updated definitions

aggregate

A manifestation that embodies multiple expressions.

aggregating expression

An expression that is the realization of an aggregating work.

aggregating work

A work that is a plan to select and arrange expressions of one or more works and embody them in an aggregate.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report Changed Terminology

- Some terms from original RDA have a new term in official RDA

controlled vocabulary A list of authorized terms to use for recording an element.	vocabulary encoding scheme (VES) A named structured list of representations of controlled values for elements.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report Terminology with Revised Definitions

- Some terms from original RDA have revised definitions in official RDA

Term	Original RDA Definition	Official RDA Definition
access point	A name, term, code, etc., representing a specific entity.	An appellation of an entity in natural language that is selected from a vocabulary encoding scheme or constructed using a string encoding scheme by an agent who creates metadata.
authorized access point	A standardized access point representing an entity.	An access point that is selected for preference in a specific application or context.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report New RDA Entities

- New entities introduced in official RDA:
 - RDA Entity
 - Agent
 - Collective Agent
 - Nomen
 - Place
 - Timespan
- Original RDA included instructions for recording places and dates as attributes. In official RDA, places and dates are recorded as relationships to the Place and Timespan entities respectively; however, there is no change in practice in MARC.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report Changed RDA Entities

- Some RDA entities have a revised definition and scope

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report New RDA Elements (1/3)

- Some new RDA elements are broader elements of existing elements

RDA Element	Definition	Domain	Range	PCC Practice
<u>date of manifestation</u>	A timespan during which a published manifestation is published, released, issued, printed, duplicated, cast, or distributed, or an unpublished manifestation is inscribed, fabricated, constructed, or otherwise produced.	Manifestation	Timespan	Typically, record a value for one or more narrower elements.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report New RDA Elements (2/3)

- Some new RDA elements are LC/PCC Core

RDA Element	Definition	Domain	Range	PCC Practice
<u>category of manifestation</u>	A type to which a manifestation belongs.	Manifestation	N/A [attribute]	LC/PCC Core for microforms, electronic resources, and serials.
<u>note on metadata work</u>	A broad unstructured description of one or more attributes of a metadata work.	Work	N/A [attribute]	LC/PCC Core in some situations.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report New RDA Elements (3/3)

- Some new RDA elements are not used by PCC

RDA Element	Definition	Domain	Range	PCC Practice
<u>category of expression</u>	A type to which an expression belongs.	Expression	N/A [attribute]	Do not record the element. The element will be evaluated for use at a future time.
<u>category of item</u>	A type to which an item belongs.	Item	N/A [attribute]	Do not record the element.
<u>manifestation statement</u>	A statement appearing in a manifestation and deemed to be significant for users to understand how the manifestation represents itself.	Manifestation	N/A [attribute]	Do not record the element.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report New Manifestation Statement Elements

- Will not be implemented by LC/PCC
- Instead, use the more specific elements covered by these broader elements
 - For Manifestation: [manifestation title and responsibility statement](#), use subelements of Manifestation: [title of manifestation](#) and Manifestation: [statement of responsibility](#)

RDA Element	Definition
manifestation title and responsibility statement	A manifestation statement about the titles of a manifestation and the names of agents who are responsible for the content of an expression that is embodied by a manifestation.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report New Representative Expression Elements

- Aspects of an expression of a work that most people think of as fundamental to the work itself (e.g., *Alice's adventures in Wonderland* is an English text intended for children)
- These aspects are sometimes referred to as “canonical”

RDA Element	Definition
<u>content type of representative expression</u>	A categorization of a representative expression that reflects the fundamental form of communication in which the content is expressed and the human sense through which it is intended to be perceived.
<u>language of representative expression</u>	A language used for the content of a representative expression of a work.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report New RDA Relationships

- New relationship elements that would have been recorded using relationship designators in original RDA
- For simplicity, only the broader elements for relationships to agents are given

RDA Element	Definition	Domain	Range	PCC Practice
<u>contributor agent to aggregate</u>	An agent who is responsible for creating an expression of a work that is embodied by an aggregate.	Manifestation	Agent	Do not record the element. Instead, record one or more narrower elements.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report New RDA Work-Work Transformation Hierarchy

- [related work of work](#)

A work that is associated with a work.

- [transformation](#)

A work that is created by changing the scope or editorial policy, the genre or literary form, the target audience, or the style of a work.

- [transformation by audience](#)

A work that is created by changing the audience of a work.

- [carrier version](#)

A work that is created by changing the carrier of a work.

- [language version](#)

A work that is created by changing the language audience of a work.

- [regional version](#)

A work that is created by changing the regional audience of a work.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report Changed Element Names

- Some official RDA elements have a different name from original RDA

Original RDA Element	Official RDA Element
<p>contributor (20.2) An agent contributing to an expression.</p> <p>Contributors include editors, translators, arrangers of music, performers, etc.</p>	<p><u>creator agent of expression</u> An agent who is responsible for a realization of a work.</p> <p>A creator of expression includes a translator, arranger of music, performer, etc. A creator of a work that is realized by an expression is also a creator of expression.</p>
<p>illustrator (I.3.1) An agent contributing to an expression of a work by supplementing the primary content with drawings, diagrams, photographs, etc.</p>	<p><u>contributor agent of still image</u> An agent who is a contributor to aggregate who creates an expression of a still image work that is embodied by an aggregate.</p>

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report Elements with a Change in Domain

- Some elements in official RDA describe a different entity (i.e., have a different domain) than in original RDA

Official RDA Element	Domain in Original RDA	Domain in Official RDA	Original RDA Definition	Official RDA Definition
<u>contributor agent of still image</u>	Expression	Manifestation	<p>illustrator An agent contributing to an expression of a work by supplementing the primary content with drawings, diagrams, photographs, etc.</p> <p>photographer (expression) ...</p>	An agent who is a contributor to aggregate who creates an expression of a still image work that is embodied by an aggregate.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report Elements with Revised Definitions

- Some elements in official RDA have a different definition than in original RDA

Element	Original RDA Definition	Official RDA Definition
<u>language of expression</u>	A language in which a work is expressed.	A language used for the content of an expression.

- In some cases, the scope of the element is different

Element	Original RDA Definition	Official RDA Definition
<u>mode of issuance</u>	A categorization reflecting whether a resource is issued in one or more parts, the way it is updated, and whether its termination is predetermined or not.	A categorization that reflects whether a manifestation is issued in one or more units.

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report General Changes in Practice (1/2)

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report Changes in Relationship Labels

- In official RDA, relationship designators became relationship elements
- Instead of using the element names, PCC uses user-friendly relationship labels listed in the MGD: [Relationship labels](#)
- In creating user-friendly relationship labels for official RDA, there are a few notable changes in the PCC-approved relationship labels:
 - Entity names are omitted when possible
 - Parenthetical qualifiers are avoided
 - Different relationship elements will use the same label

Changes from Original RDA for Monographs: Report Changes in Relationship Labels Examples

SCT RDA Training Task Group: Name Authorities

- Updating original RDA NACO training modules to reflect changes in structure, content, and LC/PCC practice
- The introductory module requires extensive revisions to account for new concepts and to introduce the generalized process for creating name authorities in official RDA
- More significant changes affect works and expressions, including the new modeling for aggregates and diachronic works, as well as the new representative expression elements

Implementation

When should PCC institutions plan to implement the official RDA Toolkit?

- As PCC continues to prepare for official RDA implementation, dates will be announced when BIBCO, CONSER, and NACO records can be created using official RDA. These dates will vary for each program based on the availability of documentation and training. Furthermore, institutions will be given sufficient time to review the documentation and training before they implement official RDA.
- **Until instructed otherwise, PCC records should continue to be created using the original RDA Toolkit.**
